

Designing a Page for an Ancient Scroll

Write and illustrate a page for an ancient scroll commemorating the important achievements of key figures in the history of the Israelites, as described in the Hebrew Bible. Orient your scroll page horizontally. Be sure to leave at least an inch of blank space along the left- and right-hand sides. For your assigned figure(s), include the following items on your scroll page:

- His name, written in both English and Hebrew.
- A title that defines his role in the development of Judaism (for example, “Father of the Jews”).
- A visual that illustrates one of his important actions for the Jewish people (for example, Solomon building the First Temple in Jerusalem).
- A one-sentence caption that explains what is shown in the visual.
- A paragraph explaining your figure’s contributions to the development of Judaism. Include a quotation from the Hebrew Bible in the paragraph.
- A small visual of one artifact, relating to some aspect of your figure’s life (for example, David’s slingshot), in each of the four corners of the page.
